

The following abbreviations describe various characteristics of daylilies listed:

***** - Denotes Tetraploid

+ - Denotes Double

Re - Reblooms

Noc – Nocturnal blooming

Fr – Fragrant

SF - Single Fan price

Sp - Spider

Unf – Unusual form

Evr – Evergreen

Sev – Semievergreen

D - Dormant

Ext – Extended opening (16 hrs or more)

Bloom timing:

E – Early season

EE – Extra early

M – Mid

ML – Mid Late

L – Late Season

Daylily National Awards – voted on yearly by AHS Accredited Garden Judges Winners have been selected as outstanding cultivars.

Len - Lennington All-American Award: Performs well in most regions of the country – Daylilies are nominated by the Awards and Honors Committee and a single cultivar is selected by the AHS Board each year.

SSM - Stout Silver Medal – AHS Garden Judges selection of the best performing daylily

AM – Award of Merit – 12 most outstanding daylilies each year receive this award, second only to the Stout Silver Medal

HM – Honorable Mention – First step of eligibility for the Stout Silver Medal – the initial “stamp of approval” by AHS Garden Judges

DF - Don Fischer Memorial Cup – Best miniature flower (less than 3”)

ATG - Annie T. Giles Award – Best small flower (over 3” but less than 4 ½”)

IM - Ida Munson Award – Best double flower (more than 6 petal segments)

DCS - Don C. Stevens Award – Best eyed or banded flower

HO - Harris Olson Spider Award – Best Spider

L/W - Lambert/Webster Award – Best Unusual Form

RWM - R.W. Munson, Jr. Award – Best “Patterned” color arrangement – as in “watermarks” or “feathering” within the eyezone or elsewhere

ESB - Best Early Season Bloom Award - Best early bloomer - these are great to show

ELD - Extra Large Diameter Award – Best flower registered as over 7” in diameter
